



**P.11.34. To note any issues relating to public rights of way in the parish and agree any actions to be taken**  
**a) To note and comment on concerns raised regarding alleged diversion of public rights of way on Littlecombe site.**

A copy of a letter from Dr Clive Mowforth to GCC regarding an alleged diversion of a footpath across the site had been received (CDU77/CCA114) and indicated evidence of a diversion to these footpaths. The letter contained 2 scanned maps showing the alleged routes along with an explanation. It was agreed that a letter should be directed at GCC to urge them to follow procedure correctly when developments are agreed but no further requests for a diversion order should be made at this stage.

**P.11.35. To consider street naming scheme for development at Everlands**

A discussion took place regarding the new proposed development at Everlands. It was agreed that the preferred option would be **Riverside** with other suggestions relating to the sports ground, scout hut and previous councillors being rejected.

**P.11.36. To receive any comments on public transport issues and agree any actions**

The Bus Network review should be added to the next agenda for discussion.

Questions were raised regarding the bollards at Cam Dursley Rail station. Members were informed that the bollards had been replaced and the ticket machine was seeming to be working well for the majority of time. No further comments/complaints had been received in the Parish office.

**P.11.37. Any Other Planning & Highway Matters for Information or Referral Only**

The following issues were raised:

**Littlecombe development** – Nothing to report regarding the postal code arrangements for Cam/Dursley

**Cam & Dursley Station** – It was noted that parking is an ever growing problem on site at the station with cars now having to park on the roadside.

**Woodend Lane** – It was noted that there was concern regarding the boundary wall protruding onto the highway at the newly built property Woodend Lane.
